

### Ramadan Fasting 5K Charity Run and Walk



On Saturday, May 18, area residents are invited to participate in the *Fasting 5K Run and Walk*, which will be at the end of a long 16-hour fast during Ramadan in Canton.

Ten cities and hundreds of athletes will embrace the spirit of the month by fasting, fundraising, and building community through this annual 5K event. The Detroit area Fasting 5K will be held in Canton, with a starting point at the Crescent Academy International located at 40440 Palmer Road in Canton. This fundraising event, scheduled to begin at 7 p.m., is open to everyone in the community and will include participants from various faiths.

This year the Run will be partnering with IMANA on supporting their SaveSmile Surgical Mission projects. IMANA performs cleft lip surgeries on small children and youth in Khartoum, Sudan. IMANA Medical Relief has been undertaking this for 9 years now and has done 1,388 successful surgeries so far. It costs \$200 for materials and medicine for each cleft lip surgery, so \$10,000 provides about 50 surgeries. 30% of all donations from each city running the Fasting 5K will go towards the international charity partner IMANA, and their SaveSmile Surgical Mission.

Since its inception in 2013, Fasting 5K has raised over \$250,000 to support local charities based in the participating cities. Fasting 5K was created to further general acts of goodness during Ramadan, which is a holy month celebrated by the Islamic faith, where healthy Muslims forgo food and water. ## Ruth's Music Notes

The opera, *The Grapes of Wrath (pictured)*, is currently showing at the Detroit Opera House.

The story of the *Grapes* of *Wrath* features the functioning of the people within the family and their close vicinity at times which are not of the best, but which hold them together through faith, work, and trouble. Hope is the guiding light, many times upheld by the constancy of the mother.

The opera *Grapes of Wrath*, composed by Rick Ian Gordon and words by Michael Korie, manages to convince us of its authenticity with the use of quite a few people onstage at the different times, clothes such as coveralls and housedresses, and some wooden tables and benches that are used to create trucks, automobiles, structures, etc.

The poverty is presented through the hard travels, difficult pregnancies, and streaming water that can serve as an instrument of torture and death as well as life-saving energy.

The music by Rick Ian Gordon is contemporary but tonal for most part and descriptive. Among the impressive musical moments was an uplifting segment depicting the drive towards the Promised Land of California. The cast in this production is excellent, one by one, such as Deanna Breiwick as Rosasharn and Michael Day as Al Joad. The little boy, Bennett Vesprint, who appears towards the end of the opera is impressive in his cry to help his

**QUESTION:** My father recently retired. He is in reasonably good health except for his feet which seem to give him problems. He acts as if that's normal and refuses to get help. Can you say something to him?

In most cases, regular Podiatric care and treatment can relieve discomfort and prevent problems.





## Detroit Premiere of Wynton Marsalis' Abyssinian Mass







11 years after its original composition, The Carr Center and Tabernacle Missionary Baptist church will present the Detroit premiere of Wynton Marsalis' sweeping masterpiece, *The Abyssinian Mass* on Saturday, May 18 at 7 p.m. at Tabernacle Missionary Baptist Church.

The event, titled *The Abyssinian Mass: A Gospel Celebration*, was commissioned by Harlem's legendary Abyssinian Baptist Church and written for a big band and 70-voice gospel choir. "The piece itself is significant artistically, but because of the forces it takes to do it, it is

not done regularly," said Oliver Ragsdale Jr., President of The Carr Center. "We have the ability to do a piece like this. It's a mobilizing piece for the community because it hasn't been done in Detroit before. It hasn't been done in Michigan before."

Four-time Grammy winner and Detroit's treasured gospel soloist, Karen Clark Sheard (pictured, left), will be a guest artist for the event alongside the Gathering Orchestra conducted by Rodney Whitaker (pictured, right), Carr Center Resident Artist in Jazz and Head of Jazz Studies at Michigan State University.

Whitaker was a member of the Jazz at Lincoln Center Orchestra under Marsalis' leadership for a number of years, and he continues to work hand-in-hand with the Pulitzer Prizewinning composer.

Carr Center Artist-in-Residence Damien Sneed (pictured, center) will lead a mighty, multi-generational choir of more than 70 performers from churches within the Detroit community.

## Meet a Best Friend or Two at the Zoo The Detroit Zoological Society (DZS) and Michigan Humane Society

(MHS), in collaboration with more than 40 local animal welfare organizations, will co-host the spring 2019 Meet Your Best Friend at the Zoo, presented by Purina, on Friday, May 17, noon to 6 p.m., and Saturday, May 18, 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. Hundreds of dogs, cats, puppies and kittens will be available for immediate adoption to loving homes at one of the nation's largest off-site companion animal adoption events.

The DZS's Berman Academy for Humane Education will continue its mission of "helping people help animals" by demonstrating to attendees how they can help their companion animals thrive. Volunteers from the DZS and MHS will show guests how to provide their pets opportunities to express natural behaviors through special toys and treats. Staff will also demonstrate how a "catio", or cat patio, allows cats to experience the outdoors while keeping birds and other wildlife safe.

To underscore the dangers of leaving pets unattended in a vehicle, a car will be on display equipped with a thermometer so guests can see firsthand how quickly the inside temperature rises compared to the outdoor temperature. 


Here's the story: three leasing reps travel to Williston, North Dakota to get mineral rights to the last big piece of undeveloped land. Leasing reps negotiate with land owners on behalf of oil companies for leases to develop the land. They typically operate on commissions which are a percentage of the leasing price. Leasing reps are also referred to as *landmen*.

Williston is a darkly funny and scintillating exploration of how business corrupts people and the fine line between commerce and conscience. With highly relevant themes of environmental issues, Native American land, protest, and patriarchy, this play has a strong message and contains strong language.

Williston is directed by resident company member Casaundra Freeman. This will be her directorial debut at the Rep, but her acting work is familiar to audiences across Southeast Michigan. She last appeared on the Rep stage in *Countdown to the Happy Day*, for which she won numerous awards.
